GOAL: \$75,000

BENEFITS

The Wiley Street acquisition will benefit the Central New York community, Sculpture Space, and resident artists.

It will help sculpture flourish in a city that is becoming increasingly recognized for its contributions to the arts.

Visiting artists who become "world ambassadors" for Central New York will reside in safe, comfortable housing, close to their studio space and its creative resources.

The Wiley Street Renovation will help revitalize West Utica, one of Central New York's most impoverished urban communities.

Sculpture Space will see savings of both time and expense.

The artists will live within easy walking distance of the studio.

Artists will develop a sense of community with their fellow sculptors who bring varying cultural backgrounds, artistic techniques, and inspirational perspectives.

BACKGROUND

Purchased in December 2009 with generous support from the **Community Foundation of Herkimer and Oneida Counties**

Cost is estimated at \$50 per square foot (as opposed to an estimated \$110 per square foot for comparable new construction). Sculpture Space will see savings of both time and expense.

THE NEED

Artists-in-residence have long praised Sculpture Space for its studio facilities, resources, and technical expertise; but the quality of housing for artists has been inconsistent and dependent on the availability of nearby rental property.



Artist housing costs currently run as much as \$1,000 per month, and coordinating housing is extremely staff-intensive.

Artists frequently work long hours to maximize their Sculpture Space experience. Safe transportation to and from the studio and security are a concern.

A COMMUNITY-BASED SOLUTION

FIRST FLOOR

- Handicapped-accessible bedroom, bathroom & kitchen
- Guest room for short-term visitors
- "Clean" studio for drawing and other conceptual planning activities where artists benefit from a quiet, distraction-free space
- Multi-purpose common room for small-group uses, including meetings and exhibition space
- Laundry facilities
- Powder room



SECOND FLOOR

- 4 artists' bedrooms
 - 2 full bathrooms
 - Common area with a full kitchen and living room
 - Balcony
- Also:
- A garage, for storage and /or extra studio space as needed
 - A backyard patio
 - Energy efficient building features are being incorporated into the design to conserve the environment as well as Sculpture Space resources
